GuideStar derives its information from 990 tax submissions to the IRS as well as directly from the nonprofit organizations themselves.

www.grantsmart.org - This site features a searchable Database of tax-related information for each of the over 60,000 private foundations that file Form 990-PF with the IRS. The Database includes images of the most recently filed IRS Form 990-PFs and information from key fields within each tax return.

www.grants.gov - THE single access point for over 1000 grant programs offered by the 26 Federal grant-making agencies.
