

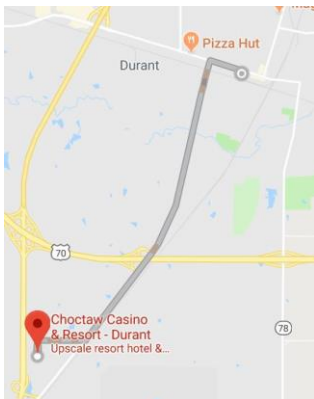
Oklahoma Museums Association Conference Wednesday Evening Events
